A pythonista in the land of PHP

- PHP dominates the landscape
 - OsCommerce
 - Lots of forks too
 - Released in 2003
 - Magento is the new kid on the block
 - 1.0 release in 2008
 - Commercial and Open Source versions
- No history of widely adopted python solutions
 - Primarily a result of python's lack of web stacks/frameworks





Ecommerce in Python

Python discovers the web

- Plone gains prominence as CMS ~ 2001
 - GetPaid 0.1 released Dec 17, 2007
- General Python frameworks hit the scene in 2005
 - Django
 - Turbogears

First Satchmo release August 22, 2007

Satchmo's History

Django's first shopping cart framework

- April 2007 The Google Group is formed
 - Goal is to use Django's features to build a customizable ecommerce framework
- August 2007 First Satchmo release
- October 2009 Satchmo 0.9 released
- Active Community
 - > 1000 Users on google groups
 - > 100 followers on bitbucket
 - > 60 Production stores
